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TIDBITS

Next Friday and Shabbos, February 23rd-24th, the 14th and 15th of Adar Rishon, is Purim Katan and Shushan Purim Katan. Lam'natzeiach is omitted. Tachanun is omitted those days, and is also omitted at Mincha on Thursday, February 22nd, the day prior to Purim Katan. The Rema concludes Orach Chaim (697) V'tov lev mishteh tamid - a good heart feasts continuously, and writes that although Purim will be celebrated next month, one should add a small festive meal on Purim Katan as well, in recognition of the miracle of Purim.

This is the seventh week of Shovavim (TaT). Next week is the final week.

As the precarious situation in Eretz Yisrael continues, each person should increase reciting tehillim or performing other mitzvos as a zechus for the many Acheinu Beis Yisrael 'in travail and captivity'.

The final opportunity for Kiddush Levanah in the USA is Friday night, February 23rd (it should preferably be recited before Friday night).

Purim Katan is next Friday, February 23rd.

Shushan Purim Katan is next Shabbos, February 24th.

TERUMAH: Campaign to collect materials for the Mishkan structure and its vessels • "They shall make for Me a sanctuary and I will dwell among them" • The Aron • The Kappores and Keruvim, from which Hashem's voice is heard • The Shulchan • The Menorah • The curtain layers of the roof • The beams and the foundation sockets • The Paroches • Arrangement of the k'lei haMishkan • The outside Mizbe'ach • The courtyard curtains and their pillars and sockets.

Haftarah: The Parashah records the donations and the building of the Mishkan. Melachim I (5:26-6:13) details the assembling of the material for the Beis Hamikdash and its construction, led by Shlomo Hamelech.

Parashas Terumah: 96 Pesukim • 2 Obligations • 1 Prohibition

1) Assemble the Mishkan and its accompanying vessels. 2) Do not remove the Aron's poles from its rings. 3) Arrange the Lechem Hapanim on the Shulchan each week.

Mitzvah highlight: When one performs a mitzvah, Hashem bestows His blessing in a manner that corresponds to the means with which the mitzvah is performed. By performing the mitzvah of Lechem Hapanim

with bread, we draw Hashem's blessings on our bread so that we will have sufficient food and sustenance.

"And they shall take for Me a donation" (Shemos 25:2)

The Parashah discusses the donations of Bnei Yisrael toward the construction of the Mishkan. However, instead of the pasuk stating "veyitnu li terumah", 'and they shall give to Me a donation', the Torah says "veyikchu" 'and they shall take'. Why say that every Jew will "take" his donation for Hashem's Mishkan?

R' Moshe Feinstein zt"l explains: The pasuk is teaching us that while it appeared on the surface that the Bnei Yisrael contributed their own wealth for the construction, the truth is that all wealth belongs to Hashem; He grants people wealth as a safekeeping, until the time that it can be contributed for a worthy cause, in this case the building of the Mishkan. When one dedicates his wealth to the Mishkan or other worthy causes with a full heart, he is justifying his acquisition of the money in the first place - to allocate it in accordance with its Owner's wishes. Therefore, the pasuk accurately states that Bnei Yisrael 'shall take for Me a donation'.
